Mountain Home's Kindergarten is located at 1310 Post Oak Road in Mountain Home, AR. There are 315 students in the Kindergarten campus. Dr. Leigh Anne Gigliotti is the Kindergarten Principal. There are 17 kindergarten classrooms. In addition, there are 7 teachers for special programs such as library, PE, speech, resource, and music. There are also 4 paraprofessionals at the Kindergarten.

Nelson-Wilks-Herron Elementary School is located at 618 N. College Street in Mountain Home, Arkansas. There are 931 students in grades 1, 2, and 3 on the campus. Mrs. Leah Cotter is the NWH Principal. Mrs. Rita Persons is the Assistant Principal. There are 43 classrooms. Additionally, 15 certified teachers have special programs such as music, library, Title I, PE, resource, etc. There are 12 paraprofessional aides at the campus.

Pinkston Middle School is located at 1301 South College in Mountain Home, Arkansas. There are approximately 900 students in grades 5, 6, and 7. Ms Michele McWilliams is Principal at Pinkston Middle School. Assistant principals are Ms Linda White and Ms Vanessa Thomas. There are 62 classrooms at Pinkston Middle School. In addition, there are 11 special teachers in such areas as special education, music, PE, GATE, and speech. There are also 9 paraprofessionals and 4 secretaries at the middle school.

Mountain Home Junior High School is located at 2301 Rodeo Drive in Mountain Home, Arkansas. There are 606 students in the Junior High, which includes grades 8 and 9. Mr. Wes Henderson is principal and Mr. Jeff Kincade is the assistant principal. There are 37 classrooms in the Junior High. In addition, there are 6 teachers for special programs such as counseling, library, PE, resource, and music. There are 9 paraprofessional aides who work with students at the school.

Mountain Home High School is located at 500 Bomber Blvd. in Mountain Home, AR. There are 875 students in grades 10, 11, and 12. Mrs. Dana Brown is the high school principal. Assistant principals are Mr. Ron Czanstkowski and Mr. George Sitkowski. The faculty is comprised of 63 certified teachers and 14 paraprofessionals. Mountain Home High School has received charter school status, granted by the Arkansas State Board of Education. Mountain Home High School is divided into three career academies, CAB, ACME and HHS.

I'm not sure where your figures are from.

Here are the enrollment figures as of March 20th, 2008:

Kindergarten - 317
Nelson-Wilks-Herron - 946
Guy Berry - 310
Pinkston Middle school - 921
Junior High school - 608
Senior High school - 848

Total enrollment - 3950

I'm not sure where the 1,232 for senior high came from. I know the enrollment has reached into the 900's before, but I don't remember being over 1,000 for grades 10 - 12.

The point is, we are under the state square footage requirement in the areas of libraries, cafeterias and P.E. space (what you are calling "multi-ourpose" areas) with the CURRENT enrollment, and the proposal is trying to forecast growth for the next ten years.
